NOTICE OF FILING

An application concerning the employment of an alien worker for the following permanent position will be filed with the U.S. Department of Labor. This Notice of Filing will be posted for at least 10 consecutive business days, ending between 30 and 180 days before filing the permanent labor certification application.

Position: Assistant Professor (Macroeconomics)

Duties: Entry-level position. Effectively teach undergraduate and graduate courses in macroeconomics, with specific emphasis in macroeconomic aspects of public policy and/or financial macroeconomics; conduct research and other scholarly activities, including the pursuit of external funding; serve as a mentor to students on their research activities; provide service to the university community.

Qualifications: Ph.D. in Economics or directly related field from a prominent and accredited university; demonstrated excellent teaching and student mentoring skills; ability to conduct high-impact research; must support the Huntsman School's focus on student success; evidence of established or emerging research stream(s) with publication potential; excellent analytical, quantitative and communication skills; demonstrated collegiality among peers and constituents; highly effective communication skills, including listening, writing, and speaking; willingness to take on responsibilities and challenges; willingness to accept some departmental and college service assignments; ability to explain complex concepts in an understandable way; ability to serve as a mentor, advisor and role model to students; ability to work productively and cooperatively with colleagues; excellent oral, written, interpersonal, and problem-solving skills; a strong commitment to stay current and professionally or academically qualified depending on appointment. Required skills and research requirements may be earned during advanced educational studies.

Salary: At least \$110,000 per academic year. (Utah State University will pay or exceed the prevailing wage, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor.)
