**NOTICE OF FILING**

An application concerning the employment of an alien worker for the following permanent position will be filed with the U.S. Department of Labor. This Notice of Filing will be posted for at least 10 consecutive business days, ending between 30 and 180 days before filing the permanent labor certification application.

Position: Assistant Professor (Natural Resources Economics & Econometrics)

Duties: Entry-level Assistant Professor position; teach courses in natural resources economics and econometrics at both undergraduate and graduate levels; develop a nationally recognized research program in natural resources that is complimentary to ongoing departmental programs, with emphasis that includes economic analyses of water, energy or climate change; obtain external funding to support the research program and collaborate with other faculty within the department and in other departments to benefit and enhance the research program; provide service to university community.

Qualifications: Ph.D. in natural resources economics, economics, agricultural economics or closely related field with expertise in specialized fields within natural resources economics; excellent oral and written communication skills; demonstrated ability to serve as mentor, advisor and role model to students; demonstrated ability to work productively and cooperatively with colleagues. Required skills requirements may be earned during advanced educational studies.

Salary: \$120,000 per year. (Utah State University will pay or exceed the prevailing wage, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor.)
